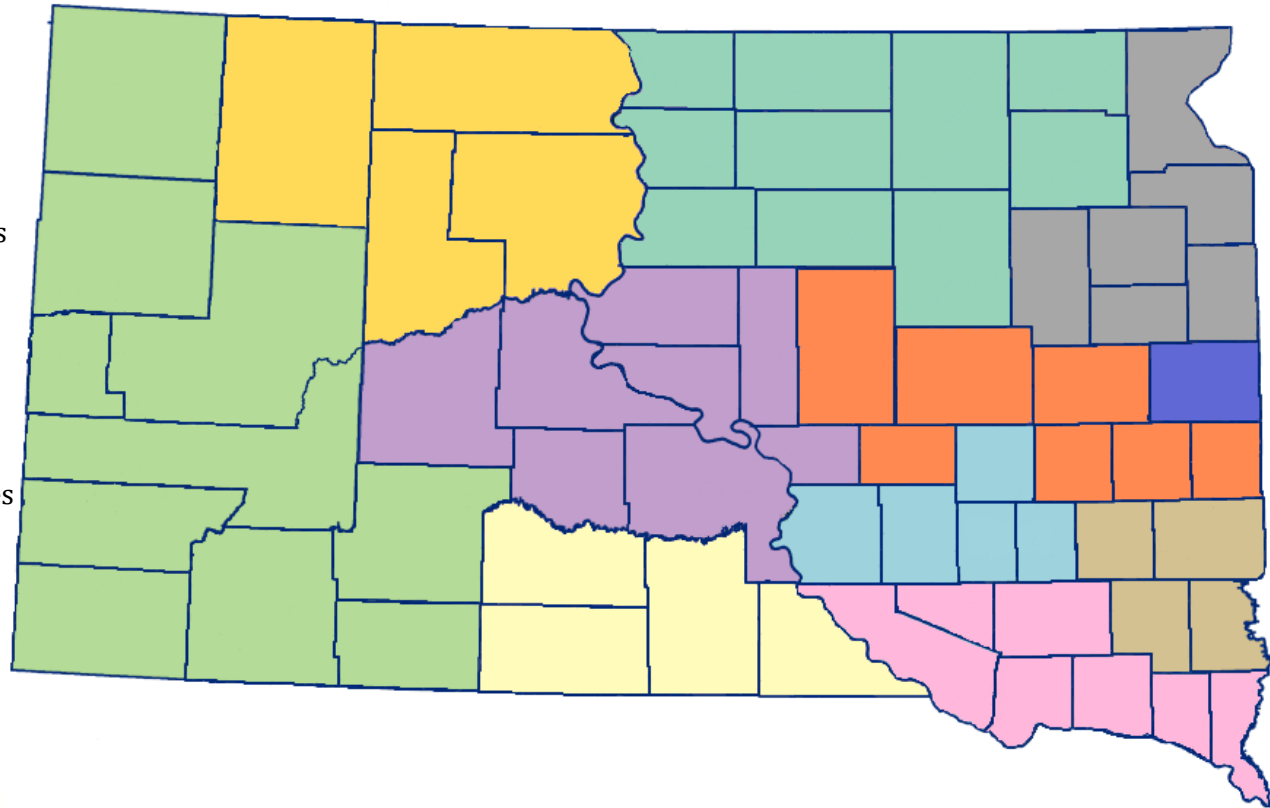

Access to Behavioral Health Providers and Services

- How to access services:

Step 1

- Contact a local behavioral health provider to schedule an appointment

Step 2

- The behavioral health provider completes an assessment to determine diagnosis and treatment needs

Step 3

- Based on the assessment, the behavioral health provider recommends behavioral health treatment services

Outpatient Services

- **Outpatient Services** – mental health services provided to individuals who do not meet full serious emotional disturbance (SED) or serious mental illness (SMI) criteria
- **Eligibility:**
 - Must have a diagnosed mental health disorder

Children, Youth, and Family Services (CYF)

- **CYF Services** – intensive and comprehensive, child-centered, family-focused, community-based, co-occurring capable, individualized integrated system of care services that provide to children under the age of 18 who meet the **Serious Emotional Disturbance (SED)** criteria
- **Eligibility:**
 - Mental disorder diagnosis
 - Functional impairment
 - Demonstrated need for services in addition to mental health services

CARE Services

- **Comprehensive Assistance with Recovery and Empowerment (CARE)** – person-centered, relationship and recovery-focused, and co-occurring capable within an integrated system of care which provides services that are medically necessary related mental health treatment, rehabilitative, and support services to adults meeting **Serious Mental Illness (SMI)** criteria
- **Eligibility:**
 - Mental disorder diagnosis
 - Has undergone psychiatric treatment more intensive than outpatient
 - Demonstrated need for services in addition to mental health services
