At YLF you will:

- Learn about your disability and others' disabilities
- Know your own strengths and weaknesses
- Gain skills to become a self-determined individual
- Learn about up-to-date available resources and assistive technology
- Identify existing barriers to personal and professional success and develop plans to overcome those barriers
- Interact with professionals with disabilities who serve as mentors and role models
- Gain the power to reach your goals in education, employment and community leadership
- Spend five days with peers your age developing a social network

Is there a cost to attend?

No. All costs, including transportation, are paid for through public and private donations.

Where do the students sleep while at YLF?

Delegates stay in dormitory suites on the NSU Campus. Males and females are separated and YLF leaders supervise students while at the dorm. A night time security guard is also present.

What happens if the student needs medical attention?

There is 24-hour nursing care available. Two nursing staff are on-site at the dorm overnight and also during all daytime activities.

What does a typical day look like at YLF?

The day generally starts with breakfast at 8:00 am in the college cafeteria. Large group presentations, handson activities, and small group activities fill the day hours. Every evening a special event, such as a picnic, dance, park activity, etc. is planned. The day ends with some free time, and lights out at 10:30 pm.

Is YLF a safe place?

YLF delegates are never alone. Delegates are divided into 4 teams, with each team having 3 leaders present to supervise and assist with whatever need the delegate may have. Delegates go to and from all activities in groups.
